## Dorset Button Wreath

I. To cover ring, follow the casting instructions for the *Dorset Buttons* Petite Project by Hope Wright, which can be found on the EGA website.



4. Continue stitching in the same manner to fill in area, overlapping threads.



2. Twist button hole edge from the outside of the ring to the inside of the ring. (Note the difference between photo I and photo 2.)



3. Begin making clockwise stitches in a herringbone style order or as labeled in photo.



5. Wrap pearl cotton, ribbon or yarn, etc. around ring and stitches, pulling each wrap taught. This will draw the center stitching inward.





6. Tie ends off on the front of the wreath.



9. Add French knots, beads, pearls, etc. for holly berries.



7. Add additional pearl cotton, ribbon, or yarn, etc. to make a bow.



10. Add pin back.



8. Tie bow and trim ends.
